What are my options? Marathon (runners), half-marathon (runners or walkers), relay (runners)

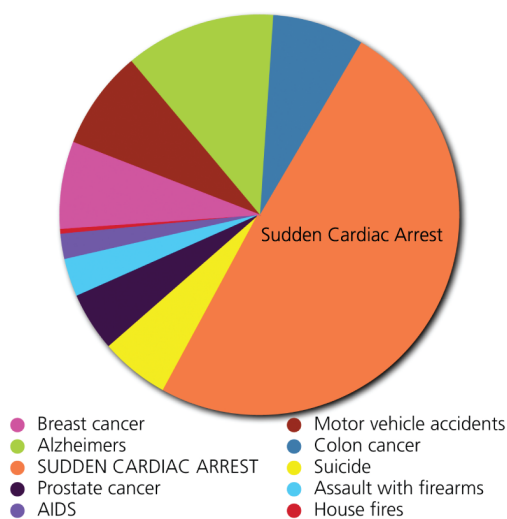
How much does it cost to register? \$250 per person, a portion of which is tax deductible
