

**WHEREAS**, approximately 250,000 people each year die from sudden cardiac arrest (SCA), making it a leading cause of death among adults over the age of 40 in the United States and other countries; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Foundation serves as the central repository of easily accessible current information on SCA, including conditions before, during, and after its occurrence; and

**WHEREAS,** Kaitlin Forbes was struck by sudden cardiac arrest at the age of 15 and saved by her physical education teacher and coach, Mike Piccione, and others at Rhinebeck High School in New York; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 15, 2009, the Sudden Cardiac Arrest Foundation will hold its 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Genesis Awards Reception to honor those who saved her life; and

**WHEREAS,** Mike Piccione will speak at the reception, and Kaitlin Forbes will join via videoconference, and other speakers will include Jamie Dixon, Head Coach, University of Pittsburgh Men's Basketball, and representatives of the Pittsburgh Public Schools; and

**WHEREAS,** the event will take place at Hyde Park on the North Shore and all proceeds will support the mission of the foundation, to raise awareness about sudden cardiac arrest and save lives.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that I, Allegheny County Executive Dan Onorato, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby proclaim October 15, 2009, "Sudden Cardiac Arrest Awareness Day" in Allegheny County.

**FURTHERMORE**, I do hereby commend the heroes whose quick and courageous actions saved Kaitlin Forbes' life.
